CY 03 TEPP Major Accomplishments

- 80 DOE-sponsored MERRTT sessions completed with 2,116 responders participating in the training
- Continuing Education Hours (CEHs) approved by the Continuing Education Coordination Board for Emergency Medical Services
- 304 student received CECBEMS credit



CY 03 TEPP Major Accomplishments

- Released second jointly FEMA and DOE produced training video and User Guide titled *Pre-hospital Practices for Handling a Radiologically Contaminated Patient*
- Supported a total of six field and tabletop exercises in AZ, GA, KY, and NM
- Conducted Practical Exercises in MA, NY, NC, GA and AL



2004 MERRTT

- Received 500+ comments on 2002 MERRTT program
- Comments have been incorporated and final review is in progress. Release date is forecast for early May 04
- Development of two additional MERRTT Modules
 - Rail Shipments
 - Safeguarded Shipments





2004 MERRTT

- Consolidating six modules into three modules
 - Shipments by DOE combined with Information Resources
 - Scene and Incident Control combined with Tactics and Strategies
 - Incident Command Response combined with Incident Command Recovery
- Addition of the two videos into the delivery schedule
- 2004 MERRTT will retain modular design
 - 18 modules and four hands-on practical exercises in the 2004 MERRTT Program
 - Designed for a 16-hour delivery
- Will be CECBEMS approved for Continuing Education Hours
- Will be OSHA reviewed as required by the WIPP Land Withdrawal Act


Future DOE and Other Agency Projects

- Post a selected number of 2004 MERRTT Modules on the FEMA Self-Study website to establish a MERRTT refresher training program
- Assist FEMA in revision of the existing Hospital Training Program
- Assisting FEMA with development of first responder radiological refresher training program
- Continue work with Department of Homeland Security and/or Office of Domestic Preparedness to identify planning and training overlaps in radiological response and planning preparedness



Future DOE and Other Agency Projects

- Oklahoma State University
 - Participate in the development of information for an addition to the Hazardous Materials Training Handbook
- Continue to work with FRPCC
 - Update compendium of federal radiological training
 - Integrate TEPP with DHS
- National Fire Protection Association
 - Participate in the review and revision of NFPA Standards 471, 472, 473 and Handbook on Hazardous Materials
